The following extract is from the Faversham News 11/8/1917
HART, Thomas Edward, Royal Garrison Artillery. Was a son of Mr & Mrs G.W. Hart of 6. Belvedere Road, and was in his 21st year. He had been serving from the commencement of the war, was drafted to the front in May and was killed in action on 31st July 1917. For some time he was employed at the Rigden's brewery, but a short time before the war he obtained employment on the railway. An older brother is also serving in the R.G.A.
