



Arthur Edwin HURLOCK - born 4th qtr 1877 in Reading (Berks)

At the time of the 1911 census he was living at 57 Sydenham Street, Whitstable, Kent with his wife and four children. His occupation was given as Builder's Handyman.

Arthur was a member of the Territorial Army Force. He joined 31 Oct 1908 at Whitstable. He was in the R.A.M.C. (Private 20083) and played Tenor Horn in their band. He was mobilized to active service at the outbreak of war, but was discharged 29 Sep 1914 as medically unfit for service following a medical examination revealed Tuberculosis.

He died 2nd qtr 1916 in Whitstable, Kent - Aged 38
